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Computers 4 People Launches Nationwide Device Donation Program

Hoboken, NJ - April 22, 2025 - In celebration of Earth Day, Computers 4 People, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit dedicated to digital inclusion, is proud to announce the launch of its nationwide device donation program, starting April 22, 2025. This new initiative allows individuals across the U.S. to easily donate their used laptops, smartphones, and tablets, completely free, by dropping them off at thousands of participating locations.

Founded in 2019 by Dylan Zajac at age 15, the organization has donated over 4,500 computers to people in need. C4P has been featured on The Kelly Clarkson Show and recognized by Forbes 30 Under 30.

A recent recipient from Staten Island said: *"I would love to say thank you to Computers 4 People. With a new return shipping system, donors simply visit www.computers4people.org/donate, fill out a brief form, receive a QR code, and drop off their boxed devices, laptops, smartphones, or tablets, at a convenient location.

Every device is securely wiped, refurbished, and donated to someone in need—or responsibly recycled to reduce e-waste.

"We're making donating technology as easy as dropping off a package," said Dylan Zajac, Founder & Executive Director. **"This is a simple way for anyone to properly dispose of toxic waste and help close the digital divide."**

With over **10 million laptops** discarded annually in the U.S., Computers 4 People removes the barriers to donation. The nonprofit receives over 1,000 applications each month from students, job seekers, and seniors who need a working device.

How It Works:

1. Visit www.computers4people.org/donate
2. Fill out the form to receive a QR code or shipping label
3. Box your device(s) - laptop, smartphone, or tablet
4. Drop them off at any participating location
5. Computers 4 People handles the rest: secure data destruction, refurbishing, and reuse or recycling
